Did you know...

- If you have data plans with T-Mobile or AT&T they have temporarily suspended data caps for the next 60 days. If you have an unlimited data plan with your cell phone you will no longer be slowed down after you hit your monthly data cap.
 - What does this mean to you: You should feel free to put your cell phone (if applicable) in hotspot to connect a device to it to use the data plan from your phone.
- Comcast is providing free high-speed internet for 2-months through their Internet Essentials package. After that it would be \$10 per month for families that qualify as low-income.
