Live Stream Information for Families

Students placed on quarantine status, home instruction, or long-term suspension are only permitted to attend school virtually via live stream when they have approval from a school official.

Parents, guardians and students are asked to recognize the following regarding classroom live stream during this period of time:

- **Live Stream Link:** Students at home join class via the link provided by the teacher; Links can be found at the top of any Schoology course.
- **Virtual Attendance Option via Live Stream:** Lessons will take place at the typical times in a student's regular schedule. Students must log on, turn on their camera, and must participate in lessons at the same time each day. To avoid disruptions, students are to report to class on time at the start of the period.
- **Cameras On!** Students are required to have their camera on during the entire class period to receive credit for attendance. *Teachers may allow students to turn cameras off from time to time based on the given learning activity.*
- **PE & Study Hall classes will NOT live stream;** students should log into Schoology during PE and complete the asynchronous assignment posted by their PE teacher. When a student's PE/Health class is meeting in a classroom for health, the teacher will live stream instruction and a link will be posted in Schoology.
- Teachers are not expected to or required to record and post live stream lessons.
- Teachers providing live stream classroom instruction will be concurrently providing face-to-face instruction to other students. Therefore, the teacher's ability to answer live stream students' questions or to provide feedback may not occur as quickly as it would in a traditional face-to-face learning environment.
- Teachers will provide materials for each lesson ahead of time through Schoology. However, during any given lesson a teacher may need to utilize different resources other than what he/she planned to use. These resources may not be immediately available to live stream students.
- Some lessons involve the use of physical resources (labs, robotics kits, manipulatives, etc.) that may not be available to live stream students; however, their learning will not be affected by this factor.
- The teacher will do his/her best to ensure that the student is able to see the essential parts of each lesson, but cannot ensure that he/she will be visible 100% of the time.
- Any student participating in a live stream for academic instruction shall abide by the district's Code of Conduct and may be held accountable for violations of the code of conduct while participating in the livestream. Students participating in a live stream of academic instruction must also be dressed in proper attire consistent with the district's dress code.
- District livestream videos are property of the district. Reposting or reproduction of videos, or screenshots from such a video is prohibited. Any recording or photos of the teacher or other students without their permission is also forbidden.
