Woolwich Twp. – Kingsway Regional High School has been ranked in the nation among the 2023-2024 [Best High Schools](#) by U.S. News & World Report – the gold standard of school ranking lists. The rankings evaluate more than 17,600 schools at the national, state and local level.

In fact, if you delve deeper into statewide rankings, Kingsway emerges as the highest ranked high school in Gloucester, Salem, Cumberland and Cape May Counties, trailing only Haddonfield, Moorestown, and Cherry Hill East, in Burlington and Camden County high schools.

Kingsway, ranked No. 140 in New Jersey and No. 69 in the Philadelphia Metropolitan Area High Schools as shown [here](#), boasts a low student-teacher ratio, high graduation rates and has been named to [College Board's AP District Honor Roll](#) with more than twenty [Advanced Placement \(AP\)](#) offerings.
